The contributions of lead individuals, researchers and writers who have generated or disseminated the corpus of knowledge are critically analyzed. The directions of research in the related disciplines of leadership and learning within the broader traditional disciplines of education are explored. The paper critically discusses the universal as well as the local dimensions of knowledge generation and dissemination in the fields of leadership and learning.



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
