



Important Notes

- Tertiary Putonghua Test (TPT) measures your Putonghua proficiency at the entry of the university
- You can get exemption from CLE Putonghua courses if you have attained required Putonghua level via TPT.
- If you have attained PSC2B or above or you do not know Chinese language, you can apply for exemption from CLE Putonghua courses.
- TPT for non-local students will be scheduled for 19/8
- All UGC-funded students have to take TPT, except Chinese-major students who will be subject to the arrangement of CHL
- Further information will be sent to your EdUHK e-mail account, not your personal email.
- If you cannot take the TPT, you should contact the general office of CLE (Ms Karina WONG at 2948-7896 or cle@eduhk.hk)
- No make up test will be provided for TPT

- •All undergraduate students admitted in 2019/20 are required to take one mandatory 3-cp Chinese enhancement course
- •except for non-Chinese-speaking (NCS) students with little or no knowledge of written Chinese and/or Cantonese
- NCS students are allowed to take either
 - •(i) one mandatory 3-cp Cantonese/Putonghua enhancement course or
 - •(ii) one of the designated courses of the same credit value (i.e. 3 credit points)
- •the result of these designated courses will not be counted towards the calculation of grade point average (GPA)



Language Exit Requirements (LERs)

- All full-time undergraduate students
- English and Putonghua
 - IELTS (International English Language Testing System)
 - · PSC (普通話水平測試)

EdUHK-sponsored Putonghua Shuiping Ceshi (PSC)

- 1. All full-time UGC-funded undergraduate students admitted in 2012/13 and onwards
- 2. take the PSC at Putonghua Training and Testing Centre (PTTC) at EdUHK free of charge for <u>once</u> after you are admitted in EdUHK, if you have not applied for reimbursement for the test fee before.

Note: Any students who took the PSC at any non-EdUHK PTTC or other PSC test centres are **NOT** eligible for reimbursement.

EdUHK-sponsored IELTS

IELTS

- All full-time UGC-funded undergraduate students admitted in 2012/13 and onwards
- for **ONCE** only

on the conditions that the students concerned took IELTS at any officially authorized IELTS testing provider in Hong Kong (i.e., British Council or IDP Education Pty Ltd) in:

- A. Years 3 and 4 (for 4-year curriculum); or
- B. Years 4 and 5 (for 5-year curriculum).

A Warm Reminder

For language enhancement, there are clearly two parts:

(a) develop language proficiency

(b) prepare for the language <u>tests</u>

(IELTS & PSC)

language learning is not only about preparing for a test language proficiency is a slow building-up process

You have to put effort along the way

Senior-year Students

- Senior-year students who are admitted to the full-time undergraduate programmes with a normal study period of two years or below
 - e.g. students who are admitted into Year-3 of 4-year programmes
 - exempted from the language enhancement courses and language exit requirements
 - optional to participate in the IELTS and/or PSC as well as to apply for the one-off sponsorship provided by the University
 - required to complete the fee-paying supplementary language enhancement courses if their IELTS and/or PSC scores fall below the requisite level (i.e., LERs for English and/or Putonghua)
