This project will provide the students with great exposure of the cutting edge of science and technology. The appointee will organize various activities in promoting the leading roles of EdUHK in STEAM education, including training camps, seminars or talks to the Primary and Secondary students and also to the public. He/she is expected to handle a full range of administrative duties and to perform other duties as assigned from time to time.

The initial appointment will be for a period of 24 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree with at least 7 years of post-qualification full-time working experience at the executive level in tertiary education institutions. They should have high proficiency in both written and spoken English and Chinese. They should also have excellent organization, communication and interpersonal skills. They should be a good team player, attentive to detail, self-motivated, and able to work under pressure and after normal office hours.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include the University's Voluntary Contributions to MPF Scheme or a contract-end lump sum payment (totaling up to 10% of the basic salary), leave, medical and dental benefits.
