The appointee will be responsible for developing and setting up the e-learning platform (training will be provided). He/she will assist in conducting literature searching and preparing learning materials about drama education. He/she will also perform other duties as assigned, including but not limited to develop, administer and conduct preliminary data analysis of the students' pre-test and post-test questionnaire; to assist the operation of the focus group interview and the sharing session after courses; to support the development of the course materials and the operation of the workshops. He/she will carry out other duties as assigned by the supervisor.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree in Humanities and related disciplines (such as language studies, literature, cultural studies). Applicants should have good skills in computer literacy (i.e. MS Word, Excel and Chinese word processing) and also have adequate computer skills to learn setting up the e-learning platform. He or she should have a good command of both written and spoken English and Chinese, as well as good interpersonal and communication skills.
