Project Title: HKJC Project - Financial Education for Upper Primary Students [Appointment Period: 2 years]

The appointee will conduct thorough evaluations and provide a wide range of research support to a sizeable project on financial education in local primary schools, such as assisting the Post-Doctoral Fellow in selecting validated measurement tools, validating tools, formulating online questionnaire surveys, using the Item Responses Theory (IRT) method in evaluative studies, liaising with stakeholders for data collection, analyzing data and writing reports, and performing other research-related duties as assigned. The initial appointment will be for two years with the possibility of renewal, subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should hold a Master's degree or above in a relevant field (e.g., finance, education, social sciences) and have a minimum of one year's post master's degree full-time working experience in program evaluation, preferably in financial education or equivalent, with proven experience in using the IRT method. Applicants should submit the curriculum vitae (CV), research statement, and references. The application materials should highlight the applicant's research experience, publications if any, and his/her alignment with the research interests of the position.

The priority will be given to applicants with strong analytical skills, attention to details, excellent communication and report-writing abilities, able to work independently and as part of a team.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits.
