Language acquisition is a multidisciplinary field studying the process by which humans acquire both spoken and written languages.

Language acquisition explores all aspects of oral language and literacy (written language) from basic research to applied research for both typically and atypically developing children and youth with a focus on the commonality and diversity of languages and scripts. With research-based evidence, the team disseminates information to enhance the learning of language and literacy and make an impact on policies and practices related to language and literacy development.
