Synopsis

What is sexual diversity? How does the social cultural experience of our personal sexuality shape our attitudes about those people who do not express their sexuality in the same ways as we do? Based on contact theory and theories in sexuality, this course aims to stimulating students to have self-reflections, knowledge enhancement and intergroup contacts to foster their appreciation of sexual diversities.

The course will cover three dimensions: awareness, knowledge, and integration. The awareness dimension includes students' critical reflections on how sexualities and their attitudes to sexualities are shaped by social cultural values. The knowledge dimension covers concepts/theories of sexuality and current social issues related to sexuality debates. Students will discuss how sexualities intersect with other social categories, such as gender, sexual orientation, disability etc. in producing barriers to equal opportunities of members from sexual minority communities. The integration part offers a space for students to appreciate sexual diversity in daily experiences in a diverse world through integration of what they have learned in the course.
