Synopsis

Positive education is a new educational paradigm that aims to better serve the needs of culturally diverse students and highly pressurized teachers in the competitive atmosphere of Hong Kong. It also intends to cultivate a sense of professionalism and pastoral care and reinforce the interpersonal competencies and leadership skills needed to create positive education schools through collaboration with parents, colleagues, school leaders, and community partners. This course utilizes a variety of pedagogical approaches such as case studies, blended learning, action learning, and reflective proactive to ensure its practical nature.
