

Double Degree Option with MCM, Melbourne University, Australia

From 2023-24 Academic Year onwards, a collaborative credit-transfer arrangement has been agreed between the Melbourne Conservatorium of Music of The University of Melbourne (MCM) and the Department of Cultural and Creative Arts of The Education University of Hong Kong (EdUHK) to offer MAME students an opportunity to also enroll in the Master of Music (Performance Teaching) [MM(PerfTeach)] programme of MCM to subsequently graduate from two Masters Degrees within a relatively shortened period of time.

How it Works

To qualify for selection in this exchange, potential applicants must be current MAME students or graduates, and:

1. Demonstrate a high musical performance standard (equivalent of ABRSM LTCL level);
2. Have completed at least 12 cps (4 courses) either within the first semester or during the first two semesters of their MA(ME) study;
3. Possess a good English standard (e.g. IELTS 6.5 or above); and
4. Passed a music proficiency audition.

Successful applicants will be given 'Advanced Standing' status by MCM to enroll in its MM(PerfTeach) programme exempted from first semester requirements. They will have to bear all financial and personal responsibilities pertaining to their studies in Australia; while their student status at EdUHK will be temporarily 'suspended'. Upon their completion of the MM(PerfTeach) Degree in Melbourne, outstanding MAME credits (12cps) could be recognized (on application) for full EdUHK MAME graduation status through credit-transfer.

Timeline and MCM MM(PerfTeach) programme structure

1. The MM(PerfTeach) programme at MCM is structured in 3 semesters. Successful MAME students with 'Advanced Standing' status may join in the 2nd Semester of the programme which operates twice in Feb-May and July-Sept every year.
