## **General Entrance Requirements**

#### HKDSE applicants must have:

- Level 3 or above in English Language and Chinese Language; AND
- Level 2 or above in Mathematics (Compulsory Part), Liberal Studies and one elective subject (excluding Applied Learning Chinese and Extended Part in Mathematics).

The Programme will also consider applicants with recognised qualifications other than HKDSE.

#### Senior Year Entry

The programme reserves a number of Senior Year (i.e. Year 3) places for quality students holding Associate Degree/Higher Diploma (or equivalent) qualifications. Admitted students are only required to take 63 cps and can complete the programme in two years. Applicants shall be considered on the basis of their academic achievements and interview performance.

### **Medium** of Instruction

The programme will be conducted mainly in English. All Major courses will be taught in English. For some non-Major courses, Putonghua or Cantonese will be adopted as the medium of instruction when the language is considered to be most effective for teaching.
