

Special Arrangements for Alumni Regarding Campus Access and Facilities

Dear Alumni,

Given the new Coronavirus COVID-19 pandemic, the University has taken various precautionary measures to reduce the potential risk of infection. These include the switch of all on-campus teaching to online mode, closure of indoor sports facilities, reduced library services, temperature checking, increased sanitisation services and restricted access.

With the above in mind, we request your support in refraining from returning to the University campus, unless absolutely necessary. For those who do require the use of campus services during this exceptional period, please take note of the special arrangements that have been put in place:

Campus access and registration

Access to the campus will be limited to those presenting EdUHK cards (e.g. “Library Borrower” and “Library Reader” cards) with specific purpose or prior appointment. Temperature checking and registration will be carried out onsite before access to the campus is granted.

Prior booking of library services

With immediate effect and until further notice, those with valid “Library Borrower” or “Library Reader” cards who wish to visit the Mong Man Wai Library on Tai Po Campus are required to register **at least two working days in advance** at <https://www.lib.eduhk.hk/visiting-registration> on a first-come-first-served basis. Those who have not successfully registered in advance will not be allowed to enter the campus. Each EdUHK cardholder is eligible to register for one session per day. For more information on sessions and quota, please visit the above webpage. They must present their “Library Borrower” or “Library Reader” cards again at the Library’s entrance on G/F.

Sports facilities

Please note that all indoor sports facilities are closed until further notice.

Wearing of face masks

Face masks must be worn at all times on campus.

We understand that these temporary arrangements may cause inconvenience to you, but these exceptional measures are devised to protect all members of the University community. We appreciate your kind understanding, and look forward to seeing you on campus when the health risk has subsided.
