

## **COVID-19 Vaccination/Regular Testing Requirements**

All regular campus users, including participants of Professional Development Programmes, must have fulfilled one of the following requirements to gain access to the campus:

- with effect from **14 January 2022**, unvaccinated regular campus users are required to produce a negative COVID-19 test result issued **within 3 days** prior to the day of campus entry. For example, if campus users enter the campus on 16 January 2022, only negative test results issued on or after 14 January 2022 will be valid.
- with effect from **24 February 2022**, all regular campus users must have received **at least one dose** of COVID-19 vaccine. Those unable to do so will be required to produce a medical certificate as proof of being unfit for vaccination.
- **by 31 March 2022**, all regular campus users must have had **two doses** of COVID-19 vaccine.

The above guidelines are applicable to classes to be delivered in Tai Po Campus, Kowloon Tong Satellite Study Centre and Tseung Kwan O Study Centre.

Campus users must use the COVID-19 Vaccination and Testing Record System to report/update their vaccination records or valid test results. Further information will be shared with registered participants in due course.

The University will continue to strictly observe stringent infection control measures in order to protect the health and safety of all campus users, and make adjustments to the above requirements at any time without prior notice.
