EdUHK English Proficiency Test (EEPT) 2023/24

EdUHK English Proficiency Test (EEPT) is organized and conducted by the Centre for Language in Education (CLE) to measure the language proficiency of the students of the University. The aim of the test is to find out your English proficiency level and where you can have improvements.

All new full-time undergraduate Year-1 students of EdUHK (excluding English major students) are required to join a compulsory EEPT unless they qualify to be exempt from the test. (See Exemptions section below and apply for an exemption by the deadline). The EEPT of this year will be held from **21 - 30 August 2023** at the Arthur Samy Language Learning Centre (B3-G-05). **There is no fee for the test.** For details of the test, please click [HERE](#).

Registration

To register for EEPT, please complete the online form [HERE](#) by **18 August 2023, 12:00 noon**. You are required to choose at least 2 timeslots for the test. Rescheduling would NOT be allowed. If you are unable to attend your test due to emergencies, please contact the eept@eduhk.hk immediately. There will NOT be any make-up tests if you fail to attend the scheduled test without a solid justification (i.e. provision of a valid medical certificate).

Consequences of not taking EEPT

Students who are required to take EEPT in the said period but failed to do so are required to take the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) (Academic) exam at any officially authorized IELTS testing provider (i.e. British Council or IDP Education Pty Ltd) **at their own expense** and to provide a valid IELTS result slip to the CLE **by the end of October 2023**.

Students who failed to do so will **NOT** be allowed to register for CLE1252 (Skills for English Language Tests I), which is a credit-bearing mandatory English Enhancement course in Year 2 Semester II, which could ultimately lead to a **delay in graduation**.

Exemptions

New students will be exempt from the EEPT if they possess the following English public examination results:

**Please present the scores from a valid certificate. The score validity is of five years counting from the date of receiving it. The certificate will be considered expired once the date crosses the validity period.

*Please present the scores from a valid certificate. The score validity is of two years counting from the date of receiving it. The certificate will be considered expired once the date crosses the validity period.
