Instructional Leadership Models Evolution (Western Perspective)

1. Early models - literature reviews, reputational studies
 - Bossert (1982): context, routine behaviors, climate & instructional organization, student outcomes
 - Hallinger & Murphy (1985): mission, instructional program, learning climate
 - Smith & Andrews (1987): resource provider, instructional resource, communicator, visible presence

Instructional Leadership Models Evolution (Western Perspective)

2. Recent models - research synthesis / meta analysis
 - Robinson (2008): goals and expectations, resources, teaching & curriculum, teacher learning & development, supportive environment
 - Leithwood (2009): rational, emotional, organizational, family



Global Trends Affecting School Leadership

- International comparisons (TIMMS, PISA)
- Policy reforms - accountability, distributing leadership, curriculum, instructional practices, extended school day
- Caution in comparing reforms across cultural contexts

Leadership Perspectives in Non- Western Cultures

1. Chinese leadership (Walker, Hu, & Haiyan)
 - Heroic
 - Politics and relationships
 - Harmony
2. East Asian culture (Pan)
 - Power distance
 - Teaching loads



Leadership in Non-Western Cultures

3. Asian perceptions of instructional leadership (Sharma)
 - Holistic view of student learning
 - Culture preservation
 - National character
4. Arab perceptions of teacher evaluation (Arar)
 - Gender expectations
 - Community expectations

Leadership in Non-Western Cultures

5. Asian perceptions of supervision (Sharma)
 - Punitive
 - Not involved in process
 - Lack content knowledge
