David is an Associate Professor in educational leadership within the Melbourne Graduate School of Education at the University of Melbourne, and has a 36-year background in secondary teaching, educational psychology, school supervision, and research in educational leadership. He is a founding member of the International Successful School Principalship Project, and the International School Leadership Development Network. He has more than 100 publications and has presented at more than 100 international conferences. David has been the Vice-president of the Australian Council for Educational Leaders and past Editor of Hot Topics, Monograph and the academic journal, Leading and Managing. He has received several honours from ACEL including being awarded the National Presidential Citation in 2004, a national fellowship in 2006, the Hedley Beare Educator of the Year award in 2012, and Gold Medal in 2014. David is a research fellow of the Asia Pacific Centre for Leadership and Change, and member of the advisory board for the International Executive Master of Arts in Educational Leadership and Change, both at the Hong Kong Institute of Education, an International Associate of the Robert Owen Centre for Educational Change at the University of Glasgow, and a Faculty Fellow at Western University in Ontario.
