Professor Dr Alma Harris is currently Director of the Institute of Educational Leadership at the University of Malaya. Her previous position was Professor of Educational Leadership at the Institute of Education, University College London. In 2010/12 she was Senior Policy Adviser to the Welsh Government and was jointly responsible for the national implementation of professional learning communities. Her research work focuses primarily on leading organizational change and development. She is internationally known for her work on school improvement, focusing particularly on improving schools in challenging circumstances. Professor Harris has written extensively about leadership in schools and she is an expert on the theme of distributed leadership. Her books 'Distributed Leadership in Schools: Developing the Leaders of Tomorrow' (Routledge) and 'Distributed Leadership Matters' (Corwin Press) have been translated into several languages. Professor Harris is Past President of the 'International Congress for School Effectiveness and School Improvement' (ICSEI) and is currently directing a major comparative study involving 7 education systems—Australia, England, Indonesia, Hong Kong, Malaysia Russia and Singapore (7systemleadershipstudy@gmail.com and #7systemstudy).
