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Prof. David Hung is currently Associate Dean of OER. He was the former Head of Educational Research Administration and Communication, OER. He is a Professor at the National Institute of Education with teaching and research interests in learning, in particular, social cultural orientations to cognition and communities of practice. He is also currently a contributing editor of Educational Technology.

Prof. Hung received his PhD from the National University of Singapore in 1997. He pursued his Master of Computing degree at Monash University, Australia in 1993 and his Bachelor of Science degree at Carleton University, Canada in 1985. He also obtained his Postgraduate Diploma from the Nanyang Technological University in 1998.

Prof. Hung has conducted research in Learning and Instructional Technologies, Constructivism and Social Constructivism, Learning in Communities of Practice, etc., during the past seven years. In 2004, he initiated the set-up of the Learning Sciences Laboratory to focus research on ICT infusion in student-centred learning.

Prof. Hung's (well over 100) publications are internationally known, and he is well recognised in the learning sciences and educational technology communities at home and abroad.

Prof. Hung has served as Contributing Editors or Associate Editors for several well-read international academic publications in the learning sciences field such as Educational Technology, and also being appointed as journal reviewer for various well established international academic journals.

Prof. Hung is Honorary Consultant of Educational Technology Division, Ministry of Education, and Consultant and Instructional Strategies Trainer for the Ministry of Defence.
