

**Dr Marcus Pietsch**

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Dr. Marcus Pietsch is a senior researcher at the Hamburg Institute for Education Monitoring and School Improvement (IfBQ), Germany, and holds a postdoctoral fellowship for Empirical Educational Research from the Leuphana University Lueneburg. He has been a visiting professor for educational measurement at the Center for International Student Assessment (ZIB) and a visiting researcher at the national Institute for Education Quality Improvement (IQB), which is situated at the Humboldt University Berlin. After a two-year employment at the International Association for the Evaluation of Educational Achievement (IEA) he also worked as researcher at the Institute for International Comparative and Intercultural Education at the University of Hamburg as well as at the Hamburg State Institute for Teacher Training and School Development (LI). His research interests include school effectiveness and improvement, evaluation and accountability in education as well as effectiveness of educational reforms and programs with a strong focus on leadership, teaching and student achievement. As a lecturer he is actively involved in the academic collaboration between the Leuphana University Lueneburg and the Education University of Hong Kong. He serves as a co-convenor for the ICSEI Methods of Researching Educational Effectiveness (MoRE) network.



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
