Professor Joseph Meng-Chun Chin has been dean of and a distinguished professor in the College of Education at the National Chengchi University, Taiwan. He received his master's degree from University of Iowa, and his Ph.D from the University of Wisconsin-Madison in educational Leadership and Administration. An active researcher, writer, and editor, he has published numerous books and journal papers in Chinese and English. His recent books include *Educational Leadership: Theories and Practices*, *International Perspective on School Choices*. He is also on the editorial boards of major journals in the field of educational administration such as *Educational Policy Forum*, *Journal of Education & Psychology*.

Professor Chin was the founder and dean of College of Education at National Chengchi University.
