Leading Schools in Eastern Asia: What We Need to Know

In 2019 Leithwood and colleagues revisited their seven strong claims about successful school leadership, updating them with the latest research knowledge. This talk will address each of these claims and comment on their applicability in the East Asian context. After recounting the reworked claims, we will comment briefly on what we believe is known about the claim in the international school leadership literature and what we think we know about the claim based on research in East Asia. Next, this discussion will identify commonalities and variations between international and Asian literature, predominantly based on English Language literature. Finally, drawing on this discussion, we will suggest several areas that require more research-based knowledge from the East Asian context. The talk aims to contribute to the ongoing development of a research agenda for school leadership in the region.
