His work explores the policy implementation process at the state, district, school, and levels, classroom focusing intergovernmental on policy-practice relations. He is author of five books including Standards Deviations (Harvard University Press), and Distributed Leadership (Jossey-Bass, 2006) as well as numerous journal articles and book chapters. Recent projects include studies of relations between organizational infrastructure and instructional advice-seeking in schools and the socialization of new school principals. He has consulted widely with government and non-government agencies in the US and around the world. In recognition of his work, Spillane was elected to the US National Academy of Education (2013) and to the American Academy of Arts and Sciences (2020).
