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Bo Ning, a PhD holder from KU Leuven, an associate professor in the Research Institute for International and Comparative Education, Shanghai Normal University, and a senior project manager in the Teacher Education Center, UNESCO. His main social affiliations include the standing member of Modern Educational Management Committee in Chinese Educational Strategy Society, a member of the Steering Committee for Xingzhi Tao Education Society in Shanghai; a chair professor of Shanghai Zizhu International Education College. In the past years, his research focus on school effectiveness and school improvement, with a specificity on school principals and school climate cultivation. He chaired 7 national and municipal research projects, with the grants from Chinese National Office for Philosophy and Social Sciences, Chinese Department of Education, Shanghai Municipal Office for Philosophy and Social Sciences. He published more than thirty papers, including 9 in SSCI journals and 10 in CSSCI journals. Recently, he published his first Chinese book entitled *An Exploration of the Post Analytic Philosophy of Education in the Great Britain* in Jilin University Press and his first English book entitled *School Climate Matters: Shanghai Schools from a Comparative Perspective* in Routledge. Meanwhile, he designed and chaired a serial of international exchange projects, including the annual exchange projects for educational administrators in the Belt and Road countries started from 2017 covering more than 100 participants from 50 countries already, the seminars for educational administrators, researchers, and school principals in APEC countries, and the capacity building projects for educational administrators and school principals in African countries, with the financial supports from Shanghai Municipality, APEC Education Network, Chinese Department of Finance, and World Bank.
