Prof. Li Zhengtao is a Doctoral Supervisor at the Faculty of Education, East China Normal University (ECNU), where he currently serves as the Deputy Director. He is also the Director of the Key Research Institute of Humanities and Social Sciences (Ministry of Education) at the Institute of Schooling Reform and Development, Dean of the "Life-Practice" Pedagogical Research Institute, and holds prominent academic roles, including Vice President of the Chinese Society of Education and Chair of the National Professional Committee of Educational Basic Theory. A distinguished scholar, he received the National Excellent Doctoral Dissertation Award in 2005, was selected for the Ministry of Education's "New Century Excellent Talents" program in 2009, and was honored as a "Young and Middle-Aged Expert with Outstanding Contributions" under the national "Millions of Talents Project" in 2015.
