~For student's performance, most students were		
engaged in playing the motivation game as they		
needed to pay attention to what the teacher said.		
~For pair work, most students were active in		
writing the rules of different places with the use of		
'must'/ 'mustn't'. Some smarter students could		
write down some new rules for the places by using		
their own ideas and words.		
Recommendations for further improvement:		
To increase student participation, besides students		
present their work and express their views on		
their classmates' work, teacher can ask students,		
"Do you think that they are good rules?" "How		
many stars would you like to give to their work?"		
At the same time, errors can be found and		
corrections can be done together.		
Also, we can use the four corners of the classroom		
to ask students to express their feelings on todays'		
pair work, like Fabulous/Excellent, Very good, Fair,		
Not good.
