The appointment is tenable for around 2 years.

Applicants for the post of Lecturer I should have a Master's degree in a relevant discipline plus a minimum of 4 years' relevant postqualification teaching experience in the subject applied for. Applicants with less teaching experience may be considered for the post of Lecturer II. Applicants should preferably possess a relevant professional teaching certificate, e.g. PGDE or qualification of Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) recognized by the Education Bureau of Hong Kong or other qualification of equivalence, and provide proven evidence of quality teaching and/or successful record of relevant professional experience, at primary/secondary and or tertiary level.
