

## Research Assistant I (Ref: RAI/SEC/1220a) Department of Special Education and Counselling

The appointee will be responsible for assisting the supervisor to develop educational computer games, and thus related background knowledge is preferred. Applicants should be familiar with at least one game-design software, such as Construct 2, Unity, Gamemaker Studio etc. In addition to game design, he/she will also be required to involve in the research projects in other aspects, including but not limited to any logistic issues on data collection, developing and preparing testing materials, participating in writing articles for publication, and any other relevant duties assigned. The appointment will be for a period of 12 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree. Those with background knowledge in computer science, especially in game design / programming, will be highly prioritized. Any training on developmental/educational psychology will be given extra credit. They should have good command in both written and spoken English and Chinese; be attentive to details; be highly self-motivated; be able to work under pressure; and have strong communication, presentation and project management skills.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits.
