

Post-doctoral Fellow (Ref: PDF/CPH/0321) Centre for Psychosocial Health

In support of the Government's Job Creation Scheme under the Anti-epidemic Fund 2.0, The Education University of Hong Kong has recently created over 40 positions covering a wide range of job functions and levels. This is in response to the difficult labour market situation in the wake of the pandemic, with an aim of providing employment opportunities for those with different skill sets, qualifications and years of experience. Applications are invited for the captioned position.

The appointee will support the research projects and programmes of the Centre for Psychosocial Health. Centered around health in school and related settings, projects and programmes have been and will be developed to address three themes: (1) adaptation and well-being in community; (2) social psychological processes for health promotion; and (3) positive health in school settings. The appointee will be responsible for managing datasets and data analysis, writing reports and publications, conducting literature review, developing research and training materials, and liaising with schools and NGOs. He/she is required to provide administrative support to carry out the projects and programmes, data collection activities, and performing any other duties as assigned by supervisor(s). The appointment will be up to a period of 12 months.

Applicants should have a Doctoral Degree in Psychology or a related discipline. They should have strong interpersonal and communication skills, good command of both written and spoken English and Chinese (including Cantonese), enthusiasm, self-motivation, and the ability to work independently, preferably with some experience in supporting research and training programmes.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Fringe benefits include leave and outpatient medical benefits.
