

## Research Assistant II (Ref: RAII/SES/0421) Department of Science and Environmental Studies

The appointee will participate in research projects related to the topics of identification, quantification, and removal of microplastics in local sewage treatment works. The major duties include assisting the team in developing experimental protocols and standard operating procedures for corresponding chemical analyses, collecting samples from selected sewage treatment works, and conducting routine chemical measurements and microbial community analysis. They will also be responsible for performing any other duties as assigned. The appointment will be for a period of 12 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language, and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B), and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent. Preference will be given to applicant who possess a Bachelor's degree in environmental engineering, chemistry, or related discipline in environmental science. Preference will be also given to applicants with good knowledge of wastewater treatment system and ability to work independently with minimal direct supervision. They should also be a good team player, attentive to details, highly self-motivated, and able to work under pressure. Immediate availability is preferred.
