

Research Assistant I (Ref: RAI/PS/0521a) Department of Psychology

In support of the Government's Job Creation Scheme under the Anti-epidemic Fund 2.0, The Education University of Hong Kong has recently created over 40 positions covering a wide range of job functions and levels. This is in response to the difficult labour market situation in the wake of the pandemic, with an aim of providing employment opportunities for those with different skill sets, qualifications and years of experience. Applications are invited for the captioned position.

The appointee will support the development and implementation of a project related to positive psychology and health psychology, named "A Better Place to Learn: School and Student Wellbeing". This project aims to develop a psychosocial educational programme to cultivate students' character strengths and life skills to help them to cope with current and future life challenges and promote their psychosocial wellbeing. It also aims to disseminate information related to positive psychology and health psychology to teachers, parents, and general public. The appointee is required to provide research and administrative support to carry out the project.

The appointee will be responsible for conducting literature review, developing research and training materials, liaising with schools, supporting data collection activities, assisting in the coordination and administrative work of the project, managing datasets, writing reports, and performing any other duties as assigned by the project team. There will be chances for manuscript writing and publications. The experience will be very useful if the appointee is planning to pursue further studies in psychology. The appointment will be for a period of 12 months.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree in Psychology or a related discipline. They should be interested in conducting research on psychology and applying psychological research in school and community settings, and have strong interpersonal and communication skills, good command of both written and spoken English and Chinese (including Cantonese), enthusiasm, self-motivation, and the ability to work independently, preferably with some experience in supporting research and training programmes.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Fringe benefits include leave and outpatient medical benefits.
