

Senior Lecturer II/ Lecturer I/II (Ref: 2100170) Department of Special Education and Counselling Faculty of Education and Human Development

The Department is now seeking qualified and highly dedicated persons for the teaching positions at the rank of Senior Lecturer II / Lecturer II / Lecturer II. The appointees will be responsible for teaching duties for undergraduate programmes and/or above; contributing to programme development; engaging in departmental and faculty services. They may also be required to supervise students on teaching practice and counselling practicum. The appointment will be for a period of three years.

The appointee(s) will participate in activities related to teaching, supervising students on practicum and projects; conducting curriculum and programme development; and performing programme and course management. Field experience supervision may also be required.

For the post of Senior Lecturer II, applicants should have a Master's degree in a relevant subject discipline plus a minimum 8 years' relevant post-qualification teaching experience in guidance and counselling and/or teaching of students with special educational needs; or preferably a Doctoral degree plus a minimum of 3 years' relevant post-qualification teaching experience in the subject applied for. For the post of Lecturer I, applicants should have a Master's degree in a relevant subject discipline plus a minimum of 4 years' relevant post-qualification teaching experience in the areas indicated above. Applicants who have less relevant post-qualification teaching experience will be considered for the post of Lecturer II.

Proven evidence of quality teaching and/or successful record of relevant professional experience at primary/secondary and/or tertiary level is required. Significant contributions to in-school curriculum development, teacher development, and/or intervention programmes in the support of students with SEN are an advantage. Applicants should preferably have experiences of teacher training in primary and/or secondary section(s) and/or teaching experiences in e-learning area, and possess a relevant professional teaching certificate, e.g. PGDE or qualification of Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) recognized by the Education Bureau of Hong Kong or other qualification of equivalence. It would be advantageous to applicants to have the ability to teach through more than one medium of instruction (English/Cantonese/Putonghua).
