The appointee will help with the management and implementation of development and research projects related to teacher professional development, classroom teaching, student learning, and resource kits of Marine education, environment education and/ or science education for primary schools and secondary schools in Hong Kong. He/she will assist the Project Leaders and team members who participate in the projects to (1) provide research support; (2) review relevant teaching and learning materials; (3) explore and design new teaching and learning activities with associated materials; and (4) support the course for participants and the implementation of the projects. The initial appointment will be for 12 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree in Education, Science, Geography, Environmental Science or related disciplines, with good command in both written and spoken English and Chinese. Knowledge, skills, and experiences in field studies, as well as learning and teaching resources packages development, are essential. He/she should also be a good team player, attentive to details, highly self-motivated, and able to work under pressure. Immediate availability is preferred.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.
