

## Research Assistant I (Ref: RAI/MIT/0721) Department of Mathematics and Information Technology

The appointment will provide support to the Principal Investigator on project arrangement. Duties include preparing test materials, interviewing teachers, documentation, liaising with internal and external stakeholders, conducting data collection and analysis and providing administrative support to scholarly activities. He/she is also required to perform any other duties as assigned. The appointment will be for a period of 12 months.

Good command of written and spoken English and Chinese (must be able to speak Cantonese) is essential. Applicants should also possess effective communication, organizational and analytical skills, be attentive to details and able to work independently. Immediate is available preferred.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.
