

Research Assistant I (Ref: RAI/C&I/0821b) Department of Curriculum and Instruction

The appointee will manage a project about developing an online platform for underprivileged students' learning for a non-governmental organisation "Principal Chan Free Tutorial World (陳校長 免費補習天地)" (https://hkcnc.org.hk/). He/she will be required to manage a team of part-time research assistants and student helpers, conduct literature review, invite and liaise with research participants, conduct interviews, transcribe and analyse data and perform other duties assigned by the project investigators. The appointment will be for a period of about 10 months, with the possibility of renewal.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree in Education, preferably with relevant post-qualification full-time working experience, or a Master Degree. They should possess the competence to manage a team and conduct data collection and analysis independently. They should have high proficiency in spoken Cantonese and English, excellent communication skills, and good written English. Preference will be given to those who are familiar with quantitative research methods. Knowledge in education-related areas (e.g., the Hong Kong school curriculum) and experience of research paper publication will be an advantage.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits.
