Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree in Chinese, linguistics or any related fields, preferably with a one year full-time work experience or a relevant Master's degree. Applicants should have an excellent command in Cantonese and Written Chinese. Knowledge in Chinese linguistics and proficiency in Hakka and/or Waitau would be an advantage.
