The appointee will be assigned to the Management Information System Team. He/She will be responsible to collaborate with a team to develop and maintain a suite of information systems/apps. The appointment will be for a period of 2 years with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Fresh graduates with good potential or those having an associate degree or a higher diploma in Information Technology, or related discipline with at least 2 years' working experience may be considered for the post of Programmer I. For the post of Programmer II, applicants should have a certificate or diploma in Information Technology or related fields. Knowledge in Web application development with **Java, XML, AJAX, JSON and relational database** is needed. Working experience in tertiary institution will be advantageous.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits.
