The Office seeks applications for one full-time position at the rank of Senior Lecturer I. Reporting directly to the Vice President (Research and Development), the appointee will be responsible for leading innovation and entrepreneurship activities under the Office of the Vice President (Research and Development) and Knowledge Transfer Sub-Office. The appointee will be engaged in applied research and knowledge transfer activities, develop teaching and learning strategies and materials for knowledge transfer activities, give guidance to staff and students in design thinking and entrepreneurship, secure external funding support, and establish partnerships with schools and other agencies, through collaboration with Faculties, Departments, Centres and Offices including but not limited to Centre for Learning, Teaching and Technology, Student Affairs Office, Entrepreneurship and Innovation Education Unit under the University Library, Office of the Chief Information Officer and other units.

Applicants should have a Master's Degree in STEM, educational technology, business administration, entrepreneurship or related subjects, plus a minimum of 8 years' relevant post-qualification teaching experience; or preferably a Doctoral Degree plus a minimum of 3 years' relevant post-qualification teaching experience.

Experience in conducting applied research and development projects in learning and teaching, and securing large-scale research and development grants will be advantageous.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits, and where applicable, housing benefits.
