

Senior Research Assistant / Research Assistant I/II (Ref: 2100641) Department of Curriculum and Instruction

In support of the Government's Job Creation Scheme under the Anti-epidemic Fund 2.0, The Education University of Hong Kong has recently created over 40 positions covering a wide range of job functions and levels. This is in response to the difficult labour market situation in the wake of the pandemic, with an aim of providing employment opportunities for those with different skill sets, qualifications and years of experience. Applications are invited for the captioned position.

The Department of Curriculum and Instruction is seeking a qualified and highly dedicated researcher to provide research support to a project related educational assessment. This project aims to promote a healthy and productive assessment culture in the context of local schools and tertiary institutions. The appointee will assist in duties such as literature review, data collection and analysis, report and journal drafting, and any other duties as assigned. The appointment will be up to a period of 12 months.

For the post of Senior Research Assistant, applicants should have a Master's Degree in Education, Psychology, or other related disciplines plus one year's post master's degree full-time working experience, or a doctorate. For the post of Research Assistant I, applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree in Education, Psychology, or other related disciplines, preferably with relevant post-qualification full-time working experience, or an approved qualification or equivalent standard. For the post of Research Assistant II, applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent. Applicants should be adept at multi-tasking, working under tight deadlines and be able to work both independently and as a team. They should also have an excellent command of written English, especially in academic writing. Knowledge and experience in research relevant to educational assessment will be an advantage.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Fringe benefits include leave and outpatient medical benefits.
