For the post of Senior Lecturer II, applicants should have a Master's degree in a relevant subject discipline plus a minimum of 8 years' relevant post-qualification teaching experience in relevant subject applied for; or preferably a Doctoral degree plus a minimum of 3 years' relevant post-qualification teaching experience in the subject applied for.

For the post of Lecturer I, applicants should have a Master's degree in a relevant subject discipline plus a minimum of 4 years' relevant post-qualification teaching experience in the subject applied for. Applicants who have less relevant post-qualification teaching experience in the subject applied for will be considered for the post of Lecturer II.

Applicants should preferably possess a relevant professional teaching certificate, e.g. PGDE or qualification of Qualified Teacher Status recognized by the Education Bureau of Hong Kong or other qualification of equivalence. Proven evidence of quality teaching and/or successful record of relevant professional experience at Kindergarten level is required. Bilingual competency in both English and Chinese and an appreciation of the challenges of working in a multicultural context will be advantageous.
