The Department is seeking a qualified and highly dedicated person to assist in teaching academic and professional development programmes for a project titled "Support for Ethnic Minority Students in Local Kindergartens for Effective Learning of Chinese". The project aims at cultivating a culturally responsive environment and creating holistic learning support to non-Chinese speaking (NCS) children in local kindergartens. EdUHK will focus on the capacity building of educators, teaching assistants, and school leaders in facilitating the NCS children to learn effectively. The appointee will participate in activities related to teaching and practicum supervision, curriculum and programme development, liaison with internal and external stakeholders, engagement of NCS students and their parents, and other duties as assigned by the project leader and the Department. The appointment will be for a period of 12 months with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should possess a relevant professional teaching certificate, e.g. Postgraduate Diploma in Education (PGDE) or qualification of Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) recognized by the Education Bureau of Hong Kong or other qualification of equivalence. Proven evidence of quality teaching and/or relevant professional experience at kindergartens is required. For the post of Lecturer I, applicants should have a Master's Degree in a related subject discipline with at least 4 years' relevant post-qualification teaching experience. Applicants with less post-qualification teaching experience may be considered for the post of Lecturer II.
