The Department of Social Sciences is looking for Senior Lecturer II or Lecturer I/II.

We seek candidate(s) who can assist with teaching courses related to the Bachelor of Education (Geography) curriculum, pedagogy, Resources Management, and courses related to environmental studies in both English and Cantonese. The appointment is tenable for two years with a possibility for renewal.

Applicants should have at least a Master's degree (MA, MSocSc, or MPhil) in related disciplines. For Lecturer I, applicants should have a minimum of 4 years' relevant post-qualification teaching experience. Applicants with less teaching experience may be considered for the post of Lecturer II. For Senior Lecturer II, applicants should have a minimum of 8 years' post-qualification teaching experience; or preferably a Doctoral degree plus a minimum of 3 years' relevant post-qualification teaching experience.

Appointee(s) will be responsible for teaching undergraduate and/or postgraduate programmes; contributing to programme development; and engaging in departmental and faculty services. He/She is also required to supervise teaching practicum and field visits and assist in administration. Preference will be given to applicants with a Doctoral degree, those who can teach courses in both English and Cantonese, and who are available immediately.

Applicants should also preferably possess a relevant professional teaching certificate, e.g. PGDE or qualification of Qualified Teacher Status recognized by the Education Bureau of Hong Kong or other qualification of equivalence. Proven evidence of quality teaching and/or successful record of relevant professional experience at primary/secondary and/or tertiary level is required. Significant contributions to in-school curriculum development will have an advantage.
