The appointee will provide research support to educational research projects in the disciplines of educational psychology. He/she will be responsible for conducting sophisticated literature review, data collection and analysis, drafting reports, and participating in all elements of the research programme. A rich background in quantitative research methodologies is essential and experience in conducting interview. The appointment will be for a period of about 6 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree in Psychology or Educational Psychology, preferably with relevant post-qualification full-time working experience, or a Master Degree. Candidates with strong background in conducting quantitative research and using statistical packages (e.g. SPSS, AMOS, Mplus) will be preferred. He/she should also possess native fluency in the language of English and Chinese, IT savvy competencies, and be proficient in language editing of English and Chinese. He/ she should be capable of working independently, detailed orientated and a good team player. Immediate availability is preferred.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Fringe benefits include leave and outpatient medical benefits.
