

Assistant Career Development Manager (Half-time) (Holding a substantive rank of Executive Officer II) (Ref: 2100673) Student Affairs Office (Career Development Section)

In support of the Government's Job Creation Scheme 2.0 under the Anti-epidemic Fund 2.0, The Education University of Hong Kong has recently created over 50 positions covering a wide range of job functions and levels. This is in response to the difficult labour market situation in the wake of the pandemic, with an aim of providing employment opportunities for those with different skill sets, qualifications and years of experience. Applications are invited for the captioned position.

The appointee will be responsible for providing a full range of administrative support and student services duties in the Student Affairs Office, such as assisting in planning and the implementation of career services and career development activities with a focus in STEM and Early Childhood Education fields; coordinating campus recruitment activities; implementing internship programmes; conducting surveys; managing databases and online resources; and supporting committee works. He/She will also supervise junior staff, perform any other duties as assigned and may be required to work outside normal office hours. The appointment will be for a period of 1 year.

Applicants should have a recognized university degree with several years of post-qualification working experience at the executive level, preferably gained in tertiary education sector, student services area and/or human resources field. They should have high proficiency in English and Chinese languages (Cantonese and Putonghua), good communication, organizational, interpersonal and numerical skills. They should also have an out-going personality; be self-initiative; result-driven with high efficiency and demonstrated interest and effectiveness in working with students. Experience in co-operating with organizations in STEM and Early Childhood Education sectors and conducting surveys will be an advantage.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.
