The appointee will be responsible for providing academic and administrative support to the research team on a project of applying artificial intelligence in learning Classical Chinese Poetry. Major duties include (a) Coordinating the design and maintenance of the application; (b) Providing administrative support for the research team; (c) Organizing workshops and seminars; (d) Producing other materials such as manuals for the teachers; (e) Preparing reports for project; (f) Other duties as assigned by the principal supervisors. The appointment will be initially made for a period of 12 months, which can be further extended upon mutual agreement.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree, preferably in Chinese language, Computer Science or Computer/Electronic Engineering. He/she should be highly self-motivated, able to work under pressure, have high proficiency of Chinese and English in reading and writing, and have good interpersonal skills. Research interest or experience in AI Mobile Application development, Natural Language Processing or related areas will be an advantage.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Fringe benefits include leave and outpatient medical benefits.
