In support of the Government's Job Creation Scheme 2.0 under the Anti-epidemic Fund 2.0, The Education University of Hong Kong has recently created over 50 positions covering a wide range of job functions and levels. This is in response to the difficult labour market situation in the wake of the pandemic, with an aim of providing employment opportunities for those with different skill sets, qualifications and years of experience. Applications are invited for the captioned position.

The appointee will provide a wide range of support in relation to various educational programmes and project initiatives for strategic development of EdUHK under the purview of the Vice President (Academic) and Provost [VP(AC) & Pr]. He/She will be responsible for providing secretarial and executive support to the development and implementation of new programmes and learning resources as well as other internal committees and meetings, facilitating collaborations and networking activities with the school sector and other experts/ leaders/ practitioners in different fields and supporting the organisation of functions, activities and events. The appointment will be for a period of around 12 months.

Applicants should have a recognised university degree preferably with post-qualification working experience. They should be highly proficient in both English and Chinese (including Cantonese and Putonghua), attentive to details, highly self-motivated and have strong communication and organisation skills. They should be adept at a multi-tasking work environment, able to work under tight deadlines, and demonstrate the ability to work both independently and as a team.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Fringe benefits include leave and outpatient medical benefits.
