The appointee will mainly provide support to the planning, executive and evaluation of knowledge transfer and research projects in the area of Life, Moral and Values Education; and/or Religious and Spiritual Education; and/or Chinese Culture and Values Education. Other duties include assisting in liaison with potential donators and other stakeholders; providing logistic support to the Centre academic, teaching and professional events and activities; providing administrative support to the Centre, such as management of databases, maintenance of IT and AV system; and performing any other duties as assigned by the Centre Director of his delegate. The appointment will be a period of 12 months with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree with not less than 4 years of post-qualification working experience, preferably with relevant teaching experiences in schools and/or with a Qualified Teacher Status and/or a Registered social worker. He/she should have good interpersonal skills; have high proficiency in Chinese and English. Experiences in Values Education, Positive Education and STEM Education related development projects will be preferred. Applicants who have less relevant post-qualification experience will be considered for the post of Project Assistant.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Fringe benefits include leave and outpatient medical benefits.
