Educational Development Manager / Assistant Educational Development Manager (Ref: 2200245) Centre for Learning, Teaching and Technology

The appointee will support a computational thinking-coding education project. Duties include teaching computational thinking (CT) and coding courses to primary school teachers, leading the curriculum team in developing and refining curriculum for in-service teachers which helps them to implement CT education in primary schools, conducting school visits and advising schools on the implementation of school-based CT curriculum, and liaising with internal and external parties. The appointee will be expected to carry out other duties as assigned by the Centre Director.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's degree, with substantial working experience in sizable organisations at managerial/ supervisory levels; strong leadership and supervisory experience; excellent interpersonal and communication skills. A Master's Degree is a plus. They should be well-versed in the local education environment, especially the primary school sector; and be able to identify the current key strategic issues in learning and teaching in primary education. Knowledge in Scratch programming, App Inventor programming, programmable robotics, such as micro:bit will be an advantage. Applicants should be proficient in both English and Chinese.

Applicants with less experience will be considered as Assistant Educational Development Manager.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits.
