The appointee will be responsible for supporting research and administrative work for a research project. Duties include assisting in conducting literature review, collecting and analyzing data, preparing manuscripts, writing reports, providing administrative support and performing any other duties as assigned. The appointment will be for a period of around 12 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

For the post of Research Assistant I, applicants should have a Bachelor's degree, preferably with good academic, in Engineering, Physics, Mathematics, Computer Science or other related fields. For the post of Research Assistant II, applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent.

Applicants should have comprehensive knowledge in computer programming. Experience in different form of machine learning and artificial intelligence will be an advantage. Practical experience in writing and building software will also be an advantage. Applicants should have an excellent command of both spoken and written English and Chinese. They should also be self-motivated and be able to work as a team member. Immediate availability is preferred.
