

Technology Development Manager (Ref: 2200282) (Holding a substantive rank of Assistant Project Manager) Research and Development Office (Knowledge Transfer Sub-Office)

The appointee will be responsible for research and technology development. Main duties include (1) designing and writing proposal for university-industry collaborative R&D projects (including but not limited to applications of HKSAR Innovation and Technology Fund) by liaising with internal units, funding bodies, industry partners and other stakeholders; (2) project execution, e.g. experimental setup, project team engagement, technology design and prototyping, project milestone and budget monitoring, etc; (3) providing consultation and support to faculty members on idea generation and proposal preparation; (4) preparing relevant agreements and reports; and (5) performing other duties as assigned by the supervisor/ Director of Knowledge Transfer. The appointment will be for a period of two years, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree, preferably a Doctoral Degree in information engineering, product engineering, computer science, chemistry, or material science with post-doctoral experience in positions such as technical manager, research assistant professor, or post-doctoral fellow. They should have a track record as a principal investigator/coordinator of research/technology grant(s). Applicants with solid experience in local research and development centres (ASTRI, NAMI, etc) or universities are highly preferred.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits.
