In support of the Government's Job Creation Scheme 2.0 under the Anti-epidemic Fund 2.0, The Education University of Hong Kong has recently created over 50 positions covering a wide range of job functions and levels. This is in response to the difficult labour market situation in the wake of the pandemic, with an aim of providing employment opportunities for those with different skill sets, qualifications and years of experience. Applications are invited for the captioned position.

The appointee will be responsible for supporting research projects. He/she will assist in searching literature, analyzing survey and interview data, wring the reports, managing administrative work, supervise part-time student helpers, and performing other duties as assigned by the project leader. The appointment will be for a period of around 9 months, and up until 30 June 2023.

Applicants should have a Master's Degree in Education, Psychology, or other related disciplines plus one year's post master's degree full-time working experience, or a doctorate. Applicants should be proficient in both written and spoken English and Chinese, self-motivated, and willing to learn to handle unfamiliar tasks. The knowledge and research experience related to formative assessment and feedback will be advantages.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Fringe benefits include leave and outpatient medical benefits.
