The appointee will be responsible for providing research support on sport coaching, sport psychology, and sport and physical activity. Duties include developing and implementing research projects; preparing literature reviews; collecting data; conducting interviews in English and Chinese, and transcribing recordings; writing papers; and other project-related administrative works. The appointee will participate in team meetings, project seminars and publications as desired. The appointment will be for a period of around 9 months with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

The applicants should have a Doctoral Degree in Physical Education, Sport Science, Psychology or other related disciplines. Experience in relevant research and journal paper writing in the above disciplines are required. They should have experience with qualitative and/or quantitative methodologies. Applicants should have an excellent command of both written English and Chinese; proficiency in spoken Cantonese. They should also be self-motivated, well-organized, have good interpersonal and communication skills, and be able to work independently and collectively as a good team member.
